MESSAGE SUMMARY

God sowed his son so we could have a position in his family. We are not called to a life mediocrity but one of blessing and anointing. It just takes that one touch of anointing to change our lives then turn around and lift those that need a touch of God. When we lift others, God will make them leap!

SCRIPTURE (do not read until prompted in the discussion questions)
Galatians 2:20 | Acts 3:1-10

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- So many of us live a mediocre life because we don't believe our position in the family of God. God wanted a family so he sowed his son to the earth to die on the cross. Because of God's seed we are now joint heirs with Jesus so whatever came to him is coming to us. Do you live like you are a joint heir with Jesus?

 What can you do today to start living like royalty?
- Since we are joint heirs with Christ we are to also serve like him. Sometimes serving is not comfortable or fun. There are times that we have to serve in areas we don't like because God wants to kill our prideful selves. The way up to the kingdom is down in a humble position. Once you humble yourself God will exalt you to a place that you've never been. *Read Galatians 2:20. What*

does it mean to you to be crucified with Christ? What does it mean for our pride and ego?

- You will never find out who you are till you have to give up who you think you are. When you went to accept Jesus in your heart, He wanted to take your whole life. You have plans for your life but if you allow God to take control of your whole life he will show you who you really are. Have you ever given FULL control over to God? Which areas do you need to let go of so God can move?
- The enemy of great is good. Ordinary is the enemy of miracles. Read Acts 3:1-10. The lame man was expecting the same kind of day as he had all the days before than. He was expecting money but God had a different plan. God wants to give us great but sometimes we stop at good because we think that's all we deserve. Elijah touched Elisha once and he dropped his mediocre life. He lived day in and out doing the same exact thing but God had more for him. Has God anointed you to do something great? Are you living in the great anointing or are you still waiting for God to come back again to remind you?
- Peter and John didn't pray over the lame man nor did they preach to the man, they SPOKE to his weakness. Sometimes we're praying to the things we should be speaking to. When they spoke they lifted him up and God made him leap. We don't need to wait for the pastor to pray or preach we, as instruments of God, are to lift people up then God will give them the strength to leap.

Go around the group and lift each other up in encouragement.

CONCLUSION

God wants to introduce you to YOU. The YOU he created and the YOU that he sees and knows. Once you find your YOU that will be the moment that YOU will serve not because YOU have to but because YOU want to. You're new YOU will live each day knowing YOU are a joint heir with Christ and have the anointing to lift others up so then they can leap and find their best selves in Christ.

We all have plans and goals that we set for ourselves but if we don't allow God to take those plans over then he will never have full control. This week put your plans at the altar of God and tell him to take FULL control.
