DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **Read Psalm 11:2-3.** Blessing will make a hater out of someone. There is the ungodly that hate your blessing but if your foundation is stable than they can't do anything to you. The enemy came to destroy our foundations that Jesus set for us so make sure you are standing on a firm foundation. If the Bible is not your source then your foundation will be cracked. **Where is the FIRST place you go to when you're going through something challenging? Who is the FIRST person you turn to during those hard times?**

- Foundations are the truths that regulate a society. When we walk around with ignorance to the word of God we walk on faulty foundations. When you add weight on your life and your character is not on a firm foundation it will separate. God is obligated to wrestle with you to make sure your foundations are solid. During your wrestling match plug in Gods foundational truths into any problem and it will work. **Which foundational truths do you plug into your life?**
(Prayer, praise, fasting, reading the word, etc.)
- God is called Abba Father and Abba means source and sustaining. God's original intent for maleness was to be a life source and sustain. And the woman has been put as a carrier and multiplier. Whatever you hand a woman she will multiply it and hand it back to you. Jesus wouldn't be here if he didn't come through a woman. **In the Bible, how did women shape the ministry of Jesus? What were the benefits of Jesus' ministry for having women around him?**
 - **Read 1 Peter 3:7.** God puts the responsibility on the man to understand the gift that he has given. It gives honor when men seek to understand that women are not like them. One of the ways to understand women is by giving honor. Honor is a kingdom foundation. A man doesn't have to be married to honor the women around him. By honoring a woman you need to try to understand her emotionally, physically, her love language and why she acts the way she does.
(These questions are NOT only for men) **Do you honor the women around you? How can you practically honor the women you come across?**

OUR CHALLENGE

Everyday we should be honoring the women in our lives. This week, call the woman that is like a mother in your life (*grandmother, aunt, mom, friend, cousin, sister, etc.*) and tell her how much you love her. You don't need a reason; you just need a phone.
