DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

 Being made is different than being created. Our parents made us, but before the foundations of the earth God created us in heaven. You know where something came from because it goes back to it when it dies. Our body was made from dirt so it goes back down to the dirt. But since our spirit was created by God, once we leave this earth we will be once again present with God in heaven. To be created by God is to be chosen out

of him. How do you think heaven will be like? Will you enjoy returning back "home"?

- After Jesus descended back to heaven he left his disciples to go around the world to teach the gospel. In the book of Acts there were 2 types of community, one in a large church setting and the other in homes, aka Lifegroups. There was community because it doesn't make sense for people to be alone. It's the relationships that we have that supply us. Since God is in people we need people in our lives to help supply our needs. I can do more with people around me. How has Lifegroup impacted your life? How can you get those around you connected into a Lifegroup?
- Read Isaiah 55:10-11. God says that when he sends out a word it will not return void. God says you are chosen out of a word and there's not a day that goes by that God isn't watching you closely. God will not let you live your life meaninglessly. You were not created to go backwards. You were created to breakthrough your next obstacle and advance. What obstacle do you need to breakthrough and advance? What will you do once you advance forward?
