1 John 4:17 | Genesis 3:8-13 | Genesis 2:7 | Mark 11:24-25

# **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Read 1 John 4:17. When you come to know Jesus then you will know who you are. Jesus didn't only come to the earth as an example for us as an example as us. When you know your identity then you can begin to release your faith. Fear is always trying to rob you of your identity. We are to be brave and courageous in the face of fear or else the enemy will try to strip you of your identity. What is one quality of Jesus that you would like to have? What is one quality of Jesus that you already have?
- Read Genesis 3:8-13. The enemy was trying to take Adam and Eve's identity from them. But even through the midst of trouble you can still hear the voice of God. God will remind us who we are and who he is in our lives. When God asked them, who told you, you were naked? He was reminding them who they were

and whose they were. God never told them they were naked; God never told you, you were sick. Be careful to the voices that you are listening to! And don't be afraid to say what God is saying to you. You will know Gods words because they will lift you up and not tear you down. What is God saying to you? What are you repeating that God has never said? (for example: I am sick, I am fat, I am unworthy, I am not good enough, etc.)

- The enemy tried to get Eve to forget who she was. And the enemy tries to put lies in our ears that if we are not a pastor, deacon, church worker, or someone with a title to receive what we need in Christ. But the Lord says that all we have to be a whosoever and we can get whatsoever. You don't have to believe the doctors report, you believe the report of the Lord. Who told you, you couldn't afford that house? In the kingdom it doesn't matter if you don't have enough money all you need is a word from the Lord. Stop settling for whatever you can get because the Lord wants to give you above and beyond. Has God given you a word for what you are believing for? Have you settled in the things you have been believing for?
- Read Matthew 9: 18-23. You need to be courageous enough not to care what anyone thinks when you are reaching out to God. Jairus didn't care that he believed in something else, he needed Jesus. The woman with the blood didn't care about the crowds, she needed Jesus. Sometimes you have to stand alone in your belief. And when people laugh at you because they don't believe in your faith, do what Jesus did and let them leave. When people are telling you to sit down and shut up, shout out louder and believe. When you believe something, you become what you believe. Are you courageous enough to let someone leave if they laugh about your faith? Have you become what you believe?

#### CHALLENGE

This week find out if you have courageous faith. We are all believing for something, so step out of your comfort zone and live out what you believe.
