### **DISCUSSION QUESTIONS**

- Many people believe the lie that God is fighting an equal devil and you are the prize. The Bible clearly states that the devil is thoroughly defeated but he still has a presence as your accuser. The enemy has taken it upon himself to gather evidence of your weaknesses and sins and point the finger at all the wrong you have done. **Read Psalm 139:1-6.** What the enemy forgets is that God knows you inside and out and loves you unconditionally. Jesus would die for you over and over again, no matter what. **What is your first reaction when you get accused of something? Since our fight is not against**

***flesh and blood (Ephesians 6:12), in the middle of an accusation, what are some things you do to make sure the enemy doesn't win?***

- **Read Isaiah 46:9-10.** The difference between God and ourselves is that we have a past, present and future; God is forever in a state of I Am. You can rest in where you are because God already knows your end. God doesn't start something until he's finished. If God has begun a thing in your life, it means that he has already finished it. If God has begun to bring you out of debt then it means that you are already out of debt. If God has begun your healing then it means you are already healed. Your life has already been written. ***What has God already started in your life? Are you truly resting in your purpose or are you still worried that things won't work out?***
- Since God already knows our end, he doesn't want us to beg him for things. **Read Philippians 4:6.** Instead of asking God to do things in your prayer time, thank him for what he has already done. "Thank you" is only done upon an act completed and the Bible says to pray with thanksgiving. Go into the throne room of God and thank him for your healing, your job, your car, your finances, your relationships and all your petitions that he has already completed. ***When you go into prayer what is the first thing you say?***

### **CHALLENGE**

This week, pay attention to your prayer time. The first words that should come out of your mouth are, "Thank you!" And anything after that is a declaration that your prayers and petitions are completed.
