Luke 18:1-8 | Luke 22:31-32 | Revelation 12:10-11 | Hebrews 4:16

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

- **Read Luke 18:1-8.** Sometimes people get tired of praying when they don't see answers. But if even the judge in the story made a decision, don't you think God will too? Jesus told this story so his disciples won't get tired of praying for the same things over and over again. God hears our prayers and will answer them, just don't quit praying. **Read Matthew 6:26-27.** **What are other things that have less value than you that are being taken care of on a daily basis?**
- **Read Luke 22:31-32.** God loves you before you even mess up. God knows what tricks the enemy has up his sleeves but he

has already given you the strength to beat your enemy. When people mess up they tend to walk away from God because of shame and guilt. But the moment that you turn back to God he doesn't want you to make up for lost time, he brings you back where you left off. ***Have you ever been in the middle of a large project and for unforeseen reasons had to start all over? Why doesn't God make us start all over?***

- **Read Revelation 12:10-11.** By the blood of Jesus you are worthy. Jesus came down to the earth to do what we couldn't do. We couldn't defeat the enemy so by the blood of Jesus we have victory. We couldn't defeat sickness so by the blood of Jesus we have health. We couldn't defeat betrayal so by the blood of Jesus we have truth. God stacks a verdict of life and freedom in your favor. ***What does a favorable verdict of life and freedom look like to you?***
- **Read Hebrews 4:16.** In the dictionary, boldly means, "in a confident and courageous way; showing a willingness to take risks." The word says to come *boldly to the throne of our gracious God*. The Lord says *boldly* because he wants you to know that you are supposed to be there. When you walk into his courtroom to pray don't think you have to come in slowly with your head down in shame, but be strong, knowing that you already have the victory! ***What does being bold look like to you? Who is the boldest person in your life?***

CHALLENGE

This week think about the word "boldly." How can you live your life in a bold fashion? How can you be a bold influencer in heaven? If God gives us rights to come boldly into the throne of grace, why are we not living on earth in boldness for God?
