SCRIPTURE (do not read until prompted in the discussion questions) Luke 7:36-50

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

• We are living on an earth that we have no control over because the enemy is in control. God brought us here to take dominion over what the enemy stole. Satan wanted Jesus to worship him so the price of the kingdom is worship. To take dominion back, we are to worship God not just on Sundays but everyday with every breath. *Has there been a time when you stopped what you were doing to worship God? Try it right now. Take a moment to stop and just worship him.*

- We talk about having a study life in the word and knowledge but do we have a worship life? Healing can come over your life but it won't happen until you worship. You can worship healing, deliverance and blessing into your hand. In worship, there is a transfer that will come from God's hands to your hands. If you worship God there may be something out of your reach that will come right where you are. *What does your worship life look like? What are you waiting for God to do? Have you tried worshipping him for your prayers?*
 - Read Luke 7:36-50. The woman was so desperate for a touch of Jesus that she walked into a room she wasn't permitted to go into. Jesus wasn't special anymore to the men in that room and they didn't even give him the typical greeting of a guest. There are times that we get so familiar with Jesus and think we are so saved that we don't accept the grace and mercy that Jesus is extending to us. But he will reach out to those that religious people think are not permitted in the room and touch them. *Have you ever been too familiar with Jesus and just gone through the motions? How can worship get you back to the awe and wonder of Christ*?
- The woman in the book of Luke was well aware of how much sin she held. She needed ultimate forgiveness from Jesus and all she knew to do was to wash his feet with the oil she had. In the same story in the book of Mark, the word says that the box was broken and when you break a container you can no longer control how it's poured. She brought her past in that box with oil and smashed it because she wanted her worship to be overwhelming. The fragrance filled the room and it became a place of extravagant worship. Do you make as much noise in church as you do at concerts or games? How can your worship be louder in his house then in the world?
- That woman didn't even have to ask Jesus for what she wanted. He knew her past, her pain, her desires, her needs and her wants. She never had to ask Jesus for forgiveness because he already knew what she came for. After her worship Jesus forgave her. Do you think that Jesus already knows your past, your pain, desires, needs and wants? How can that change the way you worship?
