LET'S TALK ABOUT IT!

- During the series, "Now What?" Pastor Ron has been preaching about what we are going to do after this pandemic and crisis is over. The defining moments in your life will happen when you respond to crisis. Everyday normal decisions usually don't define your future. What have you been doing during this time of crisis? Has your personal relationship with God grown? A crisis should make your roots grow deeper in the ground. If nothing has been happening with Christ, then you might need to rethink how you are using your time. What are some things you have done to grow deeper with Christ? Are you ready to go to the places that God wants to take
- Read John 20:1-16. Mary would not leave the tomb because of her life changing encounter with Jesus. When was the last time you had a real encounter with God? When was the last time you felt God without being in a church service or someone else leading it? When was the last time a tear came down because someone simply said the name "Jesus"? Many people know the words in the Bible but not

many people know the author. When you know God on a real level, then anything you are going through should drive you to Him. The things that have threatened your economy should drive you to God because he keeps his promises. **Read Hebrews 10:36.** The division in your home should drive you to God because he is your peacemaker. The things that have attacked your body should drive you to God because by his stripes you are healed. Now is the time to develop a relationship that maybe you have taken for granted. How did your life change the last time you had an intimate encounter with Jesus? Are you setting out time every day to allow Him to grow your roots?

• Read 2 Corinthians 4:16-18. Though you are being hard pressed in every direction, your outward pressure should be producing inner revival. You should be stirred for God now, more than ever before in your life. Do not let temporary difficulty blind you to eternal purpose. What's going on is not what's really going on. This affliction doesn't come to stay, it comes to go. This season is temporary but what you get out of it should be permanent. Now What? Intimacy with God. Embrace this time because it could be the greatest defining moment in your life. What has been your greatest defining moment in your life thus far? How can this time surpass what you have already gone through? How can you leave this crisis with revival in your spirit?

PRAYER FOCUS

This week pray for those people who don't have a relationship with God. They may be feeling fear, confusion and anger but pray for peace over their lives. Pray that if they are suffering from economic, household or health issues that they will run to God. Pray that they will open the word and find that his promises are always yes and amen.
