MAIN SCRIPTURES (read when prompted) John 6:1-3 Romans 8:28-31 Ephesians 2:4-7

LET'S TALK ABOUT IT!

 Read John 6:1-13. Jesus fed 5,000 families with only 2 fish and 5 loaves of bread. The less God has to work with, the more he intends on doing. God gets glory by doing more with less. God demonstrates glory by getting something wonderful out of something broken. If you think you don't have much to offer God, you're in a good place! He wants to take your messes and clean them up for his glory. God wants to turn your life around and make something great out of it. Have you ever thought your life was too messed up for God to fix? What advice would you give to someone you love if they told you that they messed up too much for God? Would you take your own advice and encouragement?

Read Romans 8:28-31. Since the foundations of the earth God has predestined your life. He has given you keys to the kingdom to make sure that your purpose is fulfilled. However, it is up to you if God's plan is going to be accomplished in your life. To achieve heaven's plans you will need to use heavenly keys. You can have as much of the kingdom as you want by using heavens keys. Some people want heavens things but refuse to use heavens keys. If you want heavens finances then use money keys. If you want heavens peace then use the peace keys. If you unlock the kingdom then God will unlock it but if you ignore the kingdom then God will ignore you. *Are you using God's keys or ignoring them because it takes a little bit of work? How can you start using the keys of the kingdom right now?*

Read Ephesians 2:4-7. Will you take your seat? Jesus went through everything he so he could sit at the right hand of the Father. Now Jesus has raised us up and seated us with him, but will you take your seat next to Jesus? When we take our seat with Jesus then we know whom we are and we rest in God's promises. When we know who we are we stop striving for satisfaction in this world. Once we start living knowing who we are in Christ and rest in his promises, then we can take our seat next to him. Do you live confident in the Lord? Would others describe you are striving for the Lord or for the satisfaction of the world?

PRAYER FOCUS

This week pray for those who desire more of the kingdom but don't know how to use the keys that God has given them. Everyone has a purpose but not everyone knows how to tap into it. Pray that the Lord brings them resources to help them learn and believe in God's plan for their lives.
