The Holy Spirit—the mind of Christ present on Earth—desires to reveal mysteries, impart wisdom, and communicate God's perfect plan for us. Let's explore how we can better attune ourselves to the Holy Spirit's guidance and activate God's promises through our words.

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

1. God's Eternal Perspective vs. Our Limited View

God doesn't see our lives chronologically but as a complete masterpiece that's already finished in eternity. Our journey is about stepping into what God has already ordained.

- Scripture: Isaiah 46:9-10; Psalm 37:23-24
- Questions:
 - How does understanding that God sees the end from the beginning change your perspective on your current circumstances? How might this impact your speech about your future?
 - o Psalm 37:23-24 tells us that "the steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord." In what area of your life do you need to take the next step in faith and trust that God has already ordered your path?

2. The Holy Spirit as Our Guide to God's Mysteries

The Holy Spirit searches the deep things of God and reveals them to us, giving us access to divine wisdom specifically designed for our advancement.

- **Scripture:** 1 Corinthians 2:9-11;
- Questions:
 - The Spirit reveals what God has prepared for those who love Him (1 Cor. 2:9-11). When was a time you received direction or insight through the Holy Spirit that human wisdom couldn't provide?
 - Pastor Ron mentioned that God hides things FOR us, FROM our enemy. What "hidden treasures" (Isaiah 45:3) do you believe God might be keeping in store for you that require spiritual discernment to discover?

3. Speaking God's Word to Activate His Power

When we speak what God says, we give power to His Word to become our reality. Speaking in the Spirit allows us to pray God's perfect will when our natural minds don't know how to pray.

- Scripture: 1 Corinthians 14:2
- Questions:
 - How have you experienced the power of speaking God's Word over your life? What specific scriptures could you begin declaring over areas where you need breakthrough?
 - O 1 Corinthians 14:2 describes speaking in tongues as communicating mysteries to God. What has been your experience with praying in the Spirit, and how might you grow in this spiritual practice?

CONCLUSION & CHALLENGE

We can change our toxic talk, but true direction of God's will for our lives comes when we tap into the leading and guidance of the Holy Spirit. The spirit wants to live in us and speak through us. The enemy wants to thwart God's will for me, but when we speak in the mysteries of the spirit, we can speak God's word and his will into existence. Speaking in the Holy Spirit is speaking God's utterances for my life. Let's open ourselves to receiving God's spirit into our lives. Let's pull on heaven and speak the things of God

Personal Challenge

- Set aside 15 minutes daily for "Spirit-Led Speech" connecting with the Holy Spirit through prayer and speaking God's Word
- Record insights received during these times and practice declaring specific scriptures over your circumstances

Group Challenge

- Commit to a 21-day "Speak Life" challenge focusing on one scripture daily about the power of words
- Share applications and revelations through a group chat
- Pray in the Spirit weekly for specific areas where members need divine guidance
