SERMON SUMMARY

Pastor Ron speaks on calling the church, us, back to power, prayer, and purity. In a time when culture normalizes violence, fear, and spiritual compromise, God's people must rise above the noise and demonstrate His Kingdom. Pastor challenges us to reject powerless religion and mixtures with false teachings, to recognize the reality of spiritual warfare, and to return to the authority of the Holy Spirit. The call is not just to attend church, but to walk in Kingdom demonstration where lives are set free and God's presence is revealed.

DISCUSSION

The Call to Prayer and Kingdom Perspective

God promises to heal the land when His people pray (2 Chronicles 7:14). We are called to rise above cultural arguments and crises, to fight spiritual battles in prayer rather than with human words. Kingdom people fly above division and see the bigger picture.

- Why does God place the responsibility for healing the land on His people and not the world?
Scripture: 2 Chronicles 7:14
- What does it look like to rise above cultural arguments and see from a Kingdom perspective? Isaiah 40:31
- Why is prayer the first “air battle” before any ground victory in the spiritual realm?
Ephesians 6:12

Powerless Religion vs. Demonstration of the Spirit

The modern church has often replaced God's power with programs, branding, and polished presentations. Yet Paul reminds us the Kingdom is not words alone but demonstration of the Spirit's power. Without the Holy Spirit, the church cannot transform lives or resist the enemy.

- How does powerless religion leave believers vulnerable in today's culture? Scripture: 2 Timothy 3:5
- What is the difference between persuasive words and the demonstration of the Spirit's power? Scripture: 1 Corinthians 2:4-5
- How can we as a group make room for “God moments” instead of only relying on structure and planning? Scripture: Acts 4:31



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Closing Doors to Mixture and Walking in Deliverance

Spiritual openings come through compromise—mixing Christianity with other beliefs, tolerating sin, or entertaining darkness. God calls His people to purity, because whatever we obey becomes our master. Deliverance is available through the power of the Holy Spirit, but we must shut the doors and stay filled with God's Word and Spirit.

- What are some modern examples of “mixture” that open doors to the enemy?
Scripture: Deuteronomy 18:9-12
- How does obedience to Christ protect us from bondage? Scripture: Romans 6:16
- Why is it important to not only be set free but also stay filled with God's Spirit and Word?
Scripture: Matthew 12:43-45

CONCLUSION

God is raising up a people who will walk in Kingdom power, purity, and prayer. We are called to shut the doors to compromise, rise above the noise of culture, and demonstrate the authority of Christ over darkness.

Group Challenge

As a group, identify areas where the church may have substituted polish for power. Pray together, asking God to restore a hunger for His Spirit's demonstration.

Personal Challenge

This week, evaluate your own “doors.” Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal anything in your life that opens space for compromise and shut it immediately by choosing obedience and filling your life with His Word and presence.

For Leaders: This topic can be sensitive. Remind everyone that not every problem is demonic. Encourage group members to seek both spiritual solutions and professional help when needed. Create a safe, non-judgmental space for people to share.
