Sermon Summary & Discussion Guide

Summary

This message focused on understanding our **identity in God**, recognizing His **presence**, and accessing the **power of the Holy Spirit**. Using Jacob's vision in Genesis 28, the pastor highlighted that God is always with us, even when we don't realize it. Believers are God's building, His field, and His epistle—He is actively shaping our lives. True spiritual power comes from being personally “plugged in” to the Holy Spirit, and breakthroughs restore our connection to God, enabling transformation in every area of life.

Key Takeaways

1. **Identity Matters** – Your identity in God determines how you experience life and spiritual victory.
2. **God is Present** – Act as though God is in your circumstances, workplace, and relationships.
3. **Be Plugged In** – Spiritual power comes from connection to the Holy Spirit, not dependence on others.
4. **Breakthrough Restores Connection** – God reconnects and rewires us for purpose when life knocks us off course.
5. **Live Spiritually** – Let your daily decisions, actions, and mindset flow from your spirit, not just your circumstances.

Discussion Questions

1. How does seeing yourself as God's building, field, and epistle change how you view your life and purpose?
2. How can you act as if God is present in your daily life, even when circumstances are difficult?
3. What does it look like for you to be “plugged in” to the Holy Spirit daily?
4. Share a time when God restored or reconnected you after a setback. How did it impact you?
5. What steps can you take this week to strengthen your connection to God's power and presence?



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Challenge for the Week

Plug In Daily: Take 10–15 minutes each day this week to connect with God through prayer, worship, or reading Scripture, focusing on His presence and your identity in Him. Each time you notice negative thoughts or discouragement, remind yourself: *“I am God’s building, God’s field, and God’s epistle. God is in this place, and He is with me.”*
