DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

HONEST CONVERSATIONS CREATE HEALTHY GROWTH

Leadership growth requires creating a culture where honest conversations can happen. Instead of pretending everything is perfect, leaders are to openly communicate in areas where vision and communication needed improvement. Healthy growth happens when people are willing to speak truth with humility and receive correction with maturity.

3. How can we create healthier communication in our relationships and groups?

VISION MUST BE CLEARLY COMMUNICATED

People come from different backgrounds and may not understand church culture or spiritual language automatically. Assumptions can create gaps in understanding, especially for new believers or newer members of a church community. Vision becomes powerful when it is consistently communicated in a way that everyone can understand and embrace.

1. What keeps people from consistently spending time in God's Word?
2. How has Scripture personally strengthened or guided you during a hard season?
3. What is one practical change you can make to make your time in God's Word more consistent?

LET GO OF BITTERNESS AND WALK IN FREEDOM

One of the strongest points in the message was that personal destiny is not isolated from community. People do not arrive at their purpose alone. God often works through collective vision and relationships. When people align together, individual purpose becomes stronger, healthier, and more impactful. Why is unforgiveness often harder to release than we expect?

1. What does it mean to you that individual destiny is connected to corporate destiny?
2. How has community helped shape your personal growth or calling?
3. What are some dangers of trying to pursue purpose completely alone?

It reminds us that healthy culture is built intentionally and that every person plays a role in carrying the mission forward. It's time to see ourselves as part of something bigger while we are pursuing the personal purpose God has for us.
