LET'S TALK ABOUT IT!

- Read James 3:2-6 The Bible says we all fail in many areas, but especially with our words. It states that if we are able to bridle the words we say, we will be able to control ourselves in every way. This shows that we have a mature and fully developed character. What are some areas you need to re-examine and look at the choice of words you use? Are you full of faith and speak life over one area but fall into habit or careless words about another area?
